### Findings



#### Branding / Design

The site is designed as a single page load site, with subsequent page content loaded into the existing frame of the page.

The site does not include a traditional menu, breadcrumb or search functionality as the user never 'leaves' the homepage.



#### GovCMS Considerations

The site's simple design lends itself equally toward a migration to GovCMS or to continuing to serve it up as a static site.



## Accessibility

The branding has a small number of accessibility issues (WCAG 2.0 AA).

Pages with WCAG 2.0 AA issues make it difficult for some people to use the page.

The site does not contain any AGLS Metadata, which is mandatory for all Australian Government Agency Websites.



## Responsive Design

We have not identified a favicon on the site. Favicons are a way to increase brand visibility and make your page more recognizable when browsing amongst multiple browser tabs or bookmarks.



## Broken Links

The site does not contain any internal or external broken links. Internal links include links to pages, images or web artefacts within the current site, whilst external links can include web pages hosted on external sites, scripts / web resources from public repositories and multimedia files hosted on external sites.

## Technical Recommendation

The Art is a Weapon site has a low complexity rating, with a simple design and no extended functionality. A migration to GovCMS would greatly simplify the authoring process in addition to addressing the accessibility issues that exist on the current site.

If this site is no longer actively maintained, it is already a static site and should continue to serve the content through the newly agreed approach to handling the museums static websites.
