Findings



Branding / Design

The site employs a number of page layouts including landing page, category/roll up page, interactive poster creation page (flash based) and individual item pages.

The site includes a traditional menu, but no breadcrumb or search functionality.



GovCMS Considerations

The site is relatively simple, with a conscription voting form and results page (assumed to be database driven), and a 'create your own poster' Adobe Flash enabled service (served from the *origin* website).



Accessibility

The branding has a number of accessibility issues (WCAG 2.0 A and AA) which affect the majority of site pages.

Pages with WCAG 2.0 A issues are unusable for some people, pages with WCAG 2.0 AA issues make it difficult for some people to use the page.

The site does not contain any AGLS Metadata, which is mandatory for all Australian Government Agency Websites.



Responsive Design

The site either does not have a meta viewport specified, or it is configured incorrectly. Viewports are important to ensure that page content resizes appropriately for different devices, in particular mobile and tablet.

There is some text on the site that is small and may not be legible enough for particular users. Some of the links or buttons on the site may be too small for a user to easily tap on a touchscreen.



Broken Links

The site contains a small number of internal and external broken links. Internal links include links to pages, images or web artefacts within the current site, whilst external links can include web pages hosted on external sites, scripts / web resources from public repositories and multimedia files hosted on external sites.

Technical Recommendation

If this site is no longer actively maintained, it is a perfect candidate for archiving to a static site and serving the content through the newly agreed approach to handling the museums static websites. The 'conscription voting function' would become deprecated in the event that the site was served statically.
