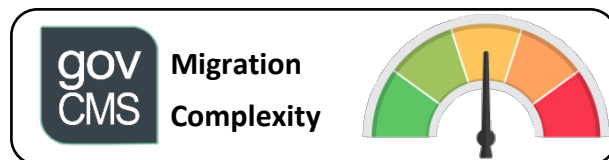

Findings



Branding / Design

The site employs a small number of page layouts including landing page, category/roll up page, search results page and individual item pages.

The site does not include a traditional menu or breadcrumb but has extensive search capabilities.



GovCMS Considerations

The site appears to be heavily database and elastic search driven; in the absence of any design documentation the analysis is limited to the content that is served publicly at the sites URL.

Observed functionality to be replicated includes:

- Metadata driven categories allowing a single item to be navigated to through multiple pathways.
- Database driven content in addition to leveraging elastic search to link tagged content and provide content refiners in search and category links for individual items.
- Leverages an API to provide election speech data in JSON format
- The *explore* section of the site makes use of complex algorithms to analyse the speeches for content, context and comprehensibility.



Accessibility

The branding has a very small number of accessibility issues (WCAG 2.0 A).

Pages with WCAG 2.0 A issues are unusable for some people.

The site does not contain any AGLS Metadata, which is mandatory for all Australian Government Agency Websites.



Responsive Design

The site either does not have a meta viewport specified, or it is configured incorrectly. Viewports are important to ensure that page content resizes appropriately for different devices, in particular mobile and tablet.

There is some text on the site that is small and may not be legible enough for particular users. Some of the links or buttons on the site may be too small for a user to easily tap on a touchscreen.



Broken Links

The site does not contain any internal or external broken links. Internal links include links to pages, images or web artefacts within the current site, whilst external links can include web pages hosted on external sites, scripts / web resources from public repositories and multimedia files hosted on external sites.

Technical Recommendation

The Election Speeches site has a medium complexity rating, requiring considerable effort to maintain the current functionality (particularly the *explore* section) on a GovCMS environment whilst maintaining the existing site structure (so as not to cause broken links as URL's change).

If the site is actively maintained and updated regularly, a move to GovCMS would fall into the **medium** complexity category requiring development of additional functionality not currently available from the out-of-the-box GovCMS Drupal 8 offering.
