Branding / Design

The site employs a single page layout across the site.

The site includes a traditional menu but no breadcrumb or search functionality.



GovCMS Considerations

The site consists of a small number of pages, currently served as a static website with no extended functionality.



Accessibility

The branding has a small number of accessibility issues (WCAG 2.0 A and AA) which affect the majority of site pages.

Pages with WCAG 2.0 A issues are unusable for some people, pages with WCAG 2.0 AA issues make it difficult for some people to use the page.

The site does not contain any AGLS Metadata, which is mandatory for all Australian Government Agency Websites.



Responsive Design

The site specifies a viewport matching the device's size, allowing it to render appropriately across devices.



Broken Links

The site does not contain any internal or external broken links. Internal links include links to pages, images or web artefacts within the current site, whilst external links can include web pages hosted on external sites, scripts / web resources from public repositories and multimedia files hosted on external sites.

Technical Recommendation

If this site is no longer actively maintained, it is already a static site and should continue to serve the content through the newly agreed approach to handling the museums static websites.
