Findings



Branding / Design

The site employs a single page layout across the site, simplifying the design and ongoing management.

The site includes a traditional menu, but no breadcrumb or search functionality.



GovCMS Considerations

The site is currently served statically (through a middleman site builder export). The design is simple and contains only a single page layout.



Accessibility

The branding has a number of accessibility issues (WCAG 2.0 A and AA) which affect the majority of site pages, these would be addressed when the branding is rebuilt on the GovCMS platform.

Pages with WCAG 2.0 A issues are unusable for some people, pages with WCAG 2.0 AA issues make it difficult for some people to use the page.

The site does not contain any AGLS Metadata, which is mandatory for all Australian Government Agency Websites.



Responsive Design

The site either does not have a meta viewport specified, or it is configured incorrectly. Viewports are important to ensure that page content resizes appropriately for different devices, in particular mobile and tablet.

We have not identified a favicon on the site. Favicons are a way to increase brand visibility and make your page more recognizable when browsing amongst multiple browser tabs or bookmarks.

There is some text on the site that is small and may not be legible enough for particular users. Some of the links or buttons on the site may be too small for a user to easily tap on a touchscreen.



Broken Links

The site contains a small number of internal and external broken links, which is to be expected for a site with extensive links to external resources. Internal links include links to pages, images or web artefacts within the current site, whilst external links can include web pages hosted on external sites, scripts / web resources from public repositories and multimedia files hosted on external sites.

Technical Recommendation

The National History Challenge site has a low complexity rating, with a simple design and no extended functionality. As the site appears to still be updated at least once a year, a migration to GovCMS would greatly simplify the authoring process in addition to addressing the accessibility issues that exist on the current site.
