Branding / Design

The site employs a single page layout.

The site does not include a traditional menu, breadcrumb or search functionality.



GovCMS Considerations

The site consists of a single page, with a relatively simple branding.



Accessibility

The branding has a small number of accessibility issues (WCAG 2.0 A and AA).

Pages with WCAG 2.0 A issues are unusable for some people, pages with WCAG 2.0 AA issues make it difficult for some people to use the page.

The site does not contain any AGLS Metadata, which is mandatory for all Australian Government Agency Websites.



Responsive Design

The site appears to be using iFrames which are discouraged as they can complicate navigation of content on mobile devices and have historically been harder to index for search engines.

We have not identified a favicon on the site. Favicons are a way to increase brand visibility and make your page more recognizable when browsing amongst multiple browser tabs or bookmarks.

Some of the links or buttons on the site may be too small for a user to easily tap on a touchscreen.



Broken Links

The site does not contain any internal or external broken links. Internal links include links to pages, images or web artefacts within the current site, whilst external links can include web pages hosted on external sites, scripts / web resources from public repositories and multimedia files hosted on external sites.

Technical Recommendation

If this site is no longer actively maintained, it is already a static site and should continue to serve the content through the newly agreed approach to handling the museums static websites.
